**Parent Permission and Acceptable Use Policy**

Students can access the school's computer network to use the Internet for learning. They have opportunities to explore sources of information and exchange communication with other users around the world. Digital online resources are for constructive educational goals; however, students may find ways to access inappropriate materials despite BIE online filtering. The benefits of student access to the Internet in the form of informational resources and opportunities for collaboration outweigh the disadvantages.

For the students' safety, they should never give out their name, address, or phone number over the Internet. Using the network is a privilege, not a right, and may be taken away if abused. The student is personally responsible for their actions in using computer resources. User activity can be tracked and monitored. Please discuss the following with your child regarding the appropriate use of technology:

*A student will not:*

- 1) Use a computer to harm or bully other people or their work.*
- 2) Damage the computer or network in any way. This includes the computer keyboard, hard drive, mouse, cables, monitor, and headphones. Replacement costs are as follows: laptop \$1400, \$300 keyboard buttons/ screens, \$40 headphones. \$20-28 power cables*
- 3) Create, view, send, or display offensive, inappropriate messages, pictures, or profane, abusive, or impolite language.*
- 4) Waste limited resources such as ink while printing without permission.*
- 5) Trespass in another person's account through e-mail, work folder, or online program.*
- 6) Modify passwords, login credentials, or computer settings.*

If technology is misused or inappropriately used, an incident report will be sent home for your information.

I have read the information about using computers and have made my child aware of their Internet privilege. However, Internet or computer use may be revoked if my child does not follow the above rules.
